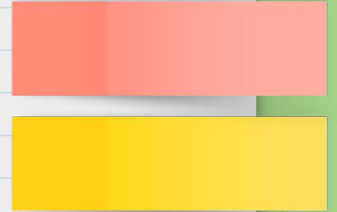

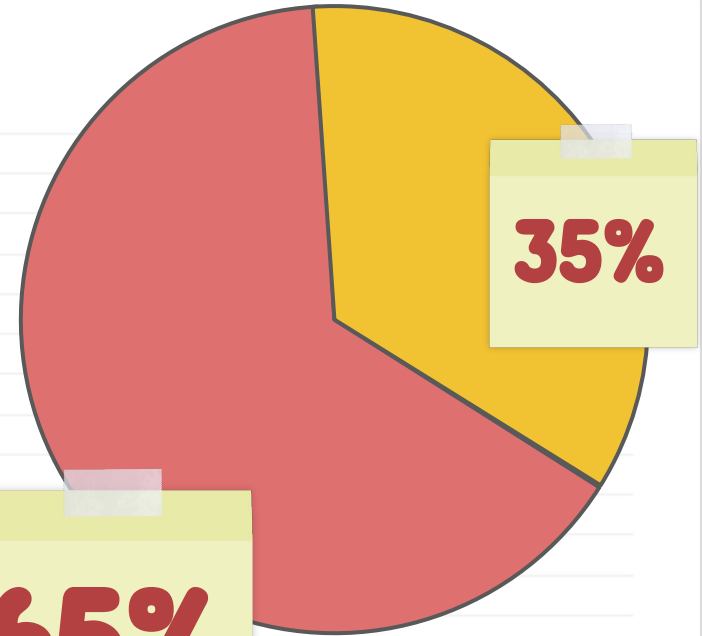

Extremely Satisfied



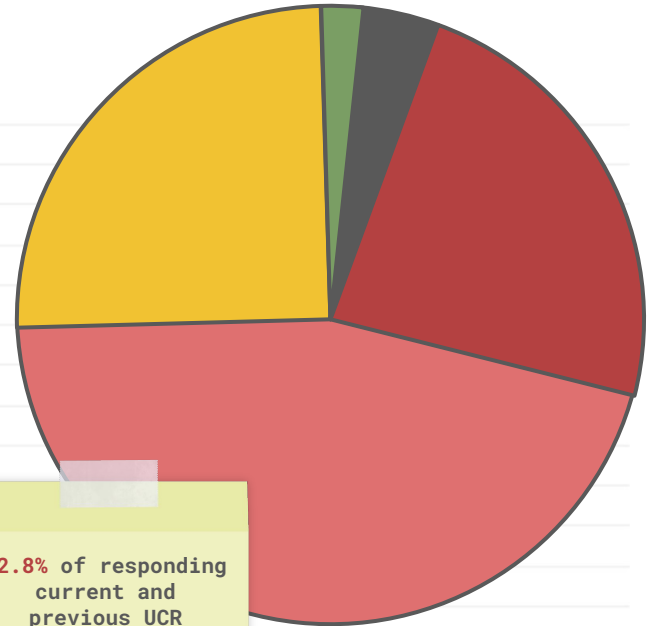
Slightly Satisfied

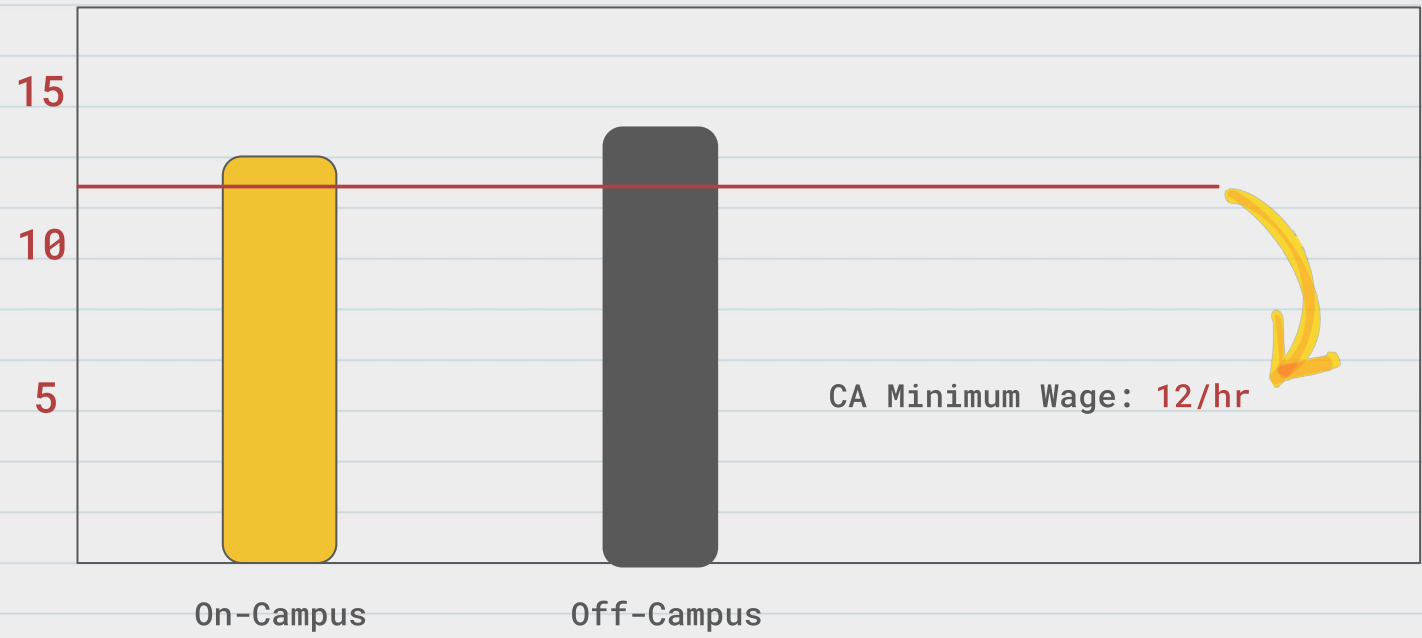

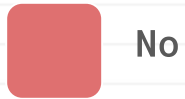

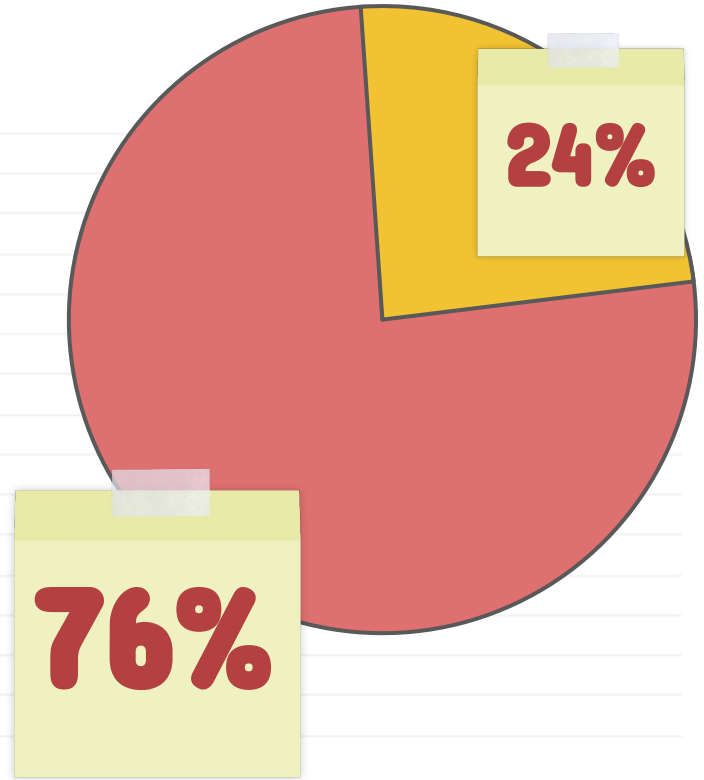
