- The results obtained are very statistically significant (p=0.00000000001846 for Chi-Square GOF)
 - We can expect the views of the entire UCR student population to share a similar distribution
- Out of all UCR students, we expect that anywhere <u>between 21.1% and</u> <u>35%</u> of students feel either <u>"uncomfortable"</u> or <u>"very uncomfortable"</u> with reporting these events to campus officials
 - 95% Confidence

- Out of all UCR students, we expect that anywhere <u>between 4.84% and</u> <u>13.9%</u> of students have <u>witnessed or experienced sexual violence</u> from a UCR member
 - 95% Confidence

- The results obtained are very statistically significant (p=0.000000000000022 for Chi-Square GOF)
 - We can expect the views of the entire UCR student population to share a similar distribution
- We expect that anywhere <u>between 43.55% and 62.33%</u> of all sexual assaults either witnessed or experienced by UCR students <u>occured</u> <u>on-campus</u>
 - 95% Confidence

After witnessing/experiencing sexual violence from a UCR member, do you believe that person was held accountable for their actions?

- Of all UCR students who have witnessed/experienced sexual violence from a UCR member, somewhere <u>between 42% and 90.4%</u> believe that person was not held accountable for their actions.
 - 95% Confidence
